The International Congress on Traditional Asian Medicine will be held at the Hyatt Bumi Hotel in Surabaya, from September 2 to 7, 1984. Arriving delegates on September 2, can check in at registration tables for the congress in the hotel to get Programs Abstracts, and other information. A welcoming party will be held in the hotel ballroom that evening.

The congress will begin at 9 a.m. on September 3, and the Scientific Program will continue until noon on the 7th, with Wednesday reserved for free time or optional tours of Java and field-trips to observe Indonesian medical institutions. A cultural performance is scheduled on Wednesday evening.

Government Sponsored Research in India :

Councils for research on the traditional systems of Asian medicine are funded by the Central Government in India and have established 117 research units throughout the country. The Councils have Scientific Advisory Commit-

tees, with the Committee for Ayurveda chaired by Dr. S. T. Gujar, Director of the Maharashtra Arogya Mandal, Hadapsar, Poona 28. and several other enterprises. The Advisory Committee for Siddha medicine is chaired by Dr. V. Raghupathy and Hakim S. Khalutathullah, 49 Bharathi Sali, Madras-600 005 who is the chairman of the Scientific Advisory Committee for Unani Medicine.

China Medical College to give Symposium in Surabaya :

The President of the China Medical College, Jung-chao Kuo, has formed a committee of the faculty to organize a day long symposium for the Second International Congress on Traditional Asian Medicine in September 1984. Prof. T. H. Chan, IASTAM Council Member, is a member of the faculty.
